Pray

Practice Truth

- 2. What do you think is the hardest thing about waiting?
- 3. Are you more likely to place your faith in a result you want or in God's character?

Leader's Tip

A small group setting lends itself to group discussion, not to a lesson. People tend to learn better when they are actively involved, and sitting in a circle makes a lesson feel awkward and a discussion feel natural.

- 4. Read Habakkuk 2:1. How did Habakkuk approach waiting with the right attitude?
- 5. Discuss the statement "If it wasn't documented, it wasn't done". How does writing things down help you remember God's faithfulness? Do you write things down? How?
- 6. Share about a time when you either waited on God or tried to force his timing. What did you learn?
