- 3. Why do you think Peter got out of the boat in vs. 28? Would you have done the same? Why or why not?
- 4. Name a storm that you've experienced in your life. How has it impacted your faith life?
- 5. Sometimes we believe that the safest place to live is in the center of God's will, yet in this story, Jesus sends his disciples into a dangerous storm. How do you reconcile these things?
