Introduction

Practice Truth

1. Icebreaker: John the Baptist was known for eating some peculiar foods. Can you name a couple? What's the strangest foods you've ever eaten?
2. What are some of the boxes you've been tempted to place God inside? How did God challenge your beliefs about him?
3. Share a time or two when God didn't follow through with something you expected him to. How did that change your perception of him?
4. How did Jesus communicate that John was getting out of prison? Why did he do it that way? How do you think John would have responded?
5. If you knew that God would use the difficult thing you are experiencing for good, would that make it easier?

Do Life Together

Matthew 11:6 seems to suggest that God will cause or at least allow bad things to happen to John and to you but along the way, don't lost heart and fall away. Does this bother you? Why would God allow John to stay in prison or allow bad things to happen to faithful people?
